May be used on harness, saddles, bridles, horse collars, shoes, boots, gloves, leather coats, etc.

Oil your leather goods at least twice a year with Primrose Neatsfoot Oil.

First apply cleaner in an inconspicuous area to verify the dye will not be lifted from the leather during the cleaning process. Wash leather thoroughly with a heavy suds composed lukewarm water and a neutral soap (castile or white toilet soap). It is unnecessary to wash light weight leather goods.

Apply neatsfoot oil in inconspicuous area to verify amount of neatsfoot oil to be used will not darken leather too much. If this is the case, adjust application accordingly; however, less application of neatsfoot oil means less protection of leather. Apply as many coats of Primrose Grade A Neatsfoot Oil as the leather will absorb without becoming greasy, rub well into leather and allow to dry, wipe off all surplus oil and leather is ready for use. All neatsfoot oil has a tendency to darken fair leather slightly
